



## **SOUNDCHECK NOTTINGHAM - THE CALL IS OUT**

Areafour Recording Industries is a new label set up as a musical antidote to the verbal abuse that so often comes Nottingham's way, giving the city's music scene a platform for its unjustly underplayed, under heard talents.

The label is launching its crusade with a compilation CD and is looking for the very best grinding guitar bands out there, from headstrong young upstarts to brash headliners.

Tracks for the label's debut CD will be chosen by a selection panel and those musicians lucky enough to win the hearts and seduce the ears of the Areafour faithful will feature on 1,000 CD's, 300 of which are destined for the UK's most influential music journalists. In addition, artists featured on the Areafour CD will also get a page on the label's website complete with photo, bio, contact details and track preview.

Bands must be Nottingham-based and tracks must be original, not cover versions, but apart from that it's all about the music. Copyright on tracks selected for the Areafour CD will stay with the musicians involved too, underlining the fact that Areafour isn't into profiting from the talents of the boys and girls it signs. It's into turning up the volume in a city where music often screams unnoticed from the rooftops and skulks in the shadows. We couldn't, and shouldn't, let that go.
